The Pop Up Prom Shoppe is open to all Lake County students with a valid high school ID.

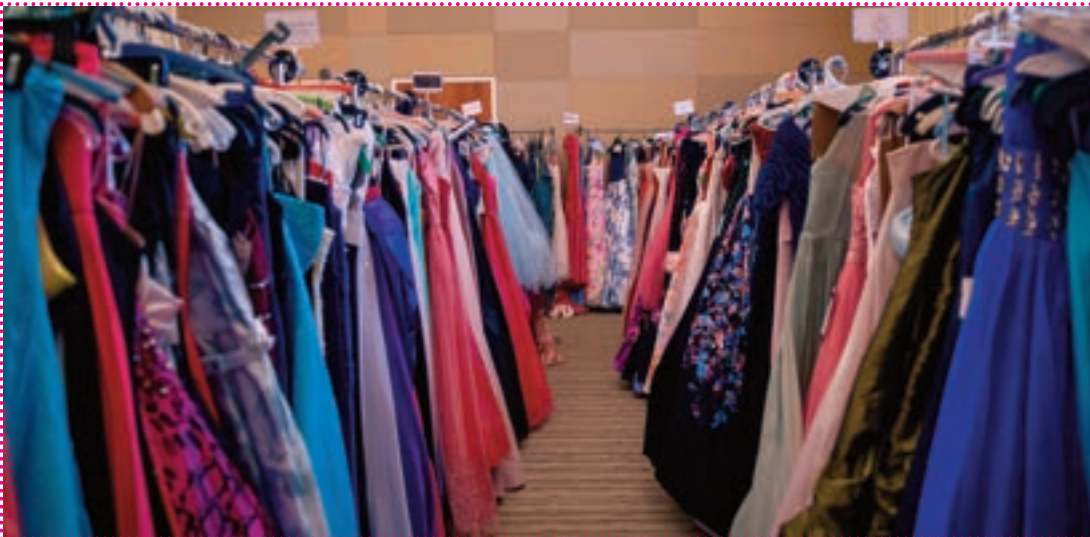
